FAVORITE VERSES

From the Book of Revelation

Revelation 1:8

"I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty."

Revelation 2:9

"I know your afflictions and your poverty—yet you are rich! I know about the slander of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan."

Revelation 3:9

"I will make those who are of the synagogue of Satan, who claim to be Jews though they are not, but are liars—I will make them come and fall down at your feet and acknowledge that I have loved you."

Revelation 3:20

"Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me."

Revelation 4:11

"You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."

Revelation 7:9

"After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb. They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands."

Revelation 12:11

"They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death."

Revelation 13:6

"The beast was given a mouth to utter proud words and blasphemies and to exercise its authority for forty-two months."

Revelation 18:4

"Come out of her, my people, so that you will not share in her sins, so that you will not receive any of her plagues."

Revelation 21:4

"He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."

Revelation 21:6

"He who was seated on the throne said, 'I am making everything new!' Then he said, 'Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.'"

Revelation 21:8

"But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars—they will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death."

Outline of the Book of Revelation:

1. **Introduction and Greetings:** John introduces himself and the purpose of his writing, addressing the seven churches in Asia (**Revelation 1:1-8**).
2. **Vision of Christ:** John describes his vision of the glorified Christ among seven golden lampstands (**Ch 1:9-20**).
3. **Letters to the Seven Churches:** Specific messages are given to the churches in Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia, and Laodicea (**Ch 2-3**).
4. **The Throne Room of Heaven:** John is taken up to heaven and describes the throne of God, surrounded by 24 elders and four living creatures (**Ch 4**).
5. **The Seven Seals:** The Lamb (Christ) opens a scroll with seven seals, each unleashing different events, including the Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse (**Ch 5-8:1**).
 - 1) First Seal opened **6:1** ~ White Horse > Conquest
 - 2) Second Seal **6:3** ~ Fiery Red Horse > War
 - 3) Third Seal **6:5** ~ Black Horse > Famine
 - 4) Fourth **Seal 6:7** ~ Pale Horse > ¼ Earth killed by sword, famine, plague, wild beasts.
 - 5) Fifth **Seal 6:9** ~ Beheaded souls under the altar.
 - 6) Sixth **Seal 6:12** ~ Earthquake, sun turned black, moon turned red, stars fall, heavens receded, mountains and islands remove.
 - A. **Ch 7** = 144,000 sealed first, great multitude in white out of great trib.
 - 7) Seventh Seal **8:1** ~ Seven Trumpets, Woman/Dragon, Seven Bowls, Fall of Babylon.
6. **The Seven Trumpets:** Seven angels blow trumpets, each bringing further judgments upon the earth, including natural disasters and plagues (**Ch 8:2-11:19**).
7. **The Woman, the Dragon, and the Beasts:** Symbolic visions of a woman, a dragon (Satan), and two beasts representing earthly powers and false prophets (**Ch 12-13**).
 - A. Lamb & 144,000 (**Ch 14a**)
 - B. Three Angels (**Ch 14b**) ~ First = Eternal Gospel; Second = Babylon is Fallen; Third = Don't worship Beast or take the mark of the Beast.
 - C. Harvest the Earth (**Ch 14c**) = Angels with reaping sickles.
8. **The Seven Bowls of Wrath:** Seven angels pour out bowls of God's wrath, resulting in severe plagues and destruction (**Ch 15-16**).
9. **The Fall of Babylon:** The symbolic city of Babylon, representing corrupt human civilization, is judged and destroyed (**Ch 17-18**).
10. **The Final Victory and New Creation:** Four "Hallelujahs" over fall of Babylon (**Ch 19**). Christ's ultimate victory over evil (**Ch 19b**), the thousand years (**Ch 20**), the final judgment (**Ch 20b**), and the creation of a new heaven and new earth where God dwells with His people (**Ch 21**), Eden Restored (**Ch 22**).
